

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS; the Regional Flood Control District strives to educate and protect residents and visitors about and from the dangers of flooding in Clark County through a flood safety awareness campaign; and
- WHEREAS; more than one-half of all flood-related deaths are the result of people attempting to drive through flooded areas; and
- WHEREAS; currently 53 detention basins and 280 miles of channels and underground storm drains have been built to protect Southern Nevadans; and
- WHEREAS; with more than 6,000 new residents moving to Clark County each month who may be unaware of the dangers of flash floods; and
- WHEREAS; it is critically important to educate the public about flood hazards, the potential for flash flooding, and how best to protect themselves in floods; and
- WHEREAS; flash floods can occur in any month of the year, and summer rains in July through September have the greatest potential to create flash floods in Clark County; now
- THEREFORE; We, the Mayor and City Council of Las Vegas, hereby proudly proclaim June to be:

in the City of Las Vegas and urge all citizens to become aware of the dangers of floods and the precautions available for their safety.




