WHEREAS; parks and recreation supplies a broad range of programs and classes which generates an opportunity for people to come together promoting a sense of community through fun recreational pursuits; and

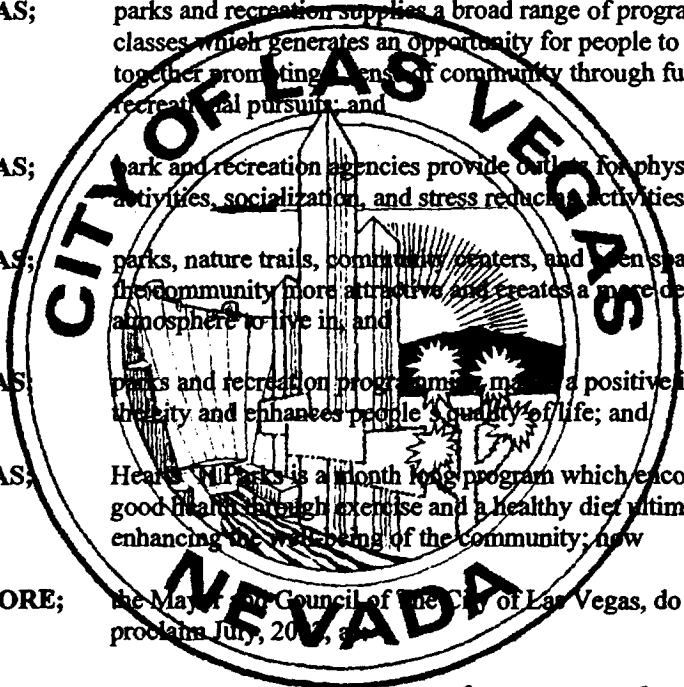
WHEREAS; park and recreation agencies provide outlets for physical activities, socialization, and stress reduction activities; and

THEREFORE; the Mayor and Council of the City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim July, 2007, as





Recreation and Parks Month

Be it further resolved that all citizens are encouraged to join in this nationwide celebration bringing recognition to all the benefits derived from quality public recreation and park resources at the local level.


