A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR:

2 By virtue of the authority vested in me, I do hereby designate and
3 proclaim

4 Friday, April 14, 1922

5 as
6 ARBOR DAY

7 in conformity with the law providing for the observance of said
8 day and requiring that it be observed as a holiday by the public
9 schools of the State.

10 I do hereby designate and proclaim the same date as a time for the
11 observance of

12 BIRD DAY

13 in accordance with custom followed
14 in Nevada during recent years.

15 I recommend that Arbor Day be observed by the people in the plant-
16 ing of trees, shrubs and vines; in the promotion of forest growth
17 and culture; in the adornment of public and private grounds, places
18 and ways and in such other ways as may be in harmony with the
19 character of that day. Bird Day appeals for the protection of
20 birds from wanton slaughter both because of the fact that birds
21 protect plant life and save great sums annually, and the fact that
22 manifestations of cruelty and destructiveness ought to be checked
23 in the young as a part of education.

24 It shall be lawful for Boards of County Commissioners, other municipal
25 authorities and school trustees to provide for the observance of
26 exercises appropriate to Arbor Day and Bird Day earlier than the
27 date above designated in their respective districts in that part of
28 Nevada south of the Mount Diablo base line.
