

P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the Western Area is adopting Daylight Saving Time effective 2:00 o'clock A.M., March 14, 1948; and

WHEREAS, there exists an acute shortage of electrical power throughout California, Northern Nevada and the western states generally, for which reason there is an urgent need to conserve electrical energy; and

WHEREAS, it is apparently the desire and will of the majority of the citizens of Clark County to enjoy a maximum amount of sunshine and to have the business hours of the day so regulated and established as to promote the aims and purposes of the maxim, "Fun in the Sun"; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the governing heads of the cities of Las Vegas, Nevada and North Las Vegas, Nevada and of the County of Clark, State of Nevada, to be in conformity with all other areas and counties in the State of Nevada,

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned, being the governing heads of the cities of North Las Vegas, Nevada, Las Vegas, Nevada and Clark County, Nevada, do hereby decree and proclaim that at 2:00 o'clock A.M., Sunday, March 14, 1948, the County of Clark, State of Nevada, and all of the incorporated cities within said county will observe Daylight Saving Time by then and there advancing time clocks one hour.

This Proclamation to be in force and effect until the present emergency has passed, and all citizens, residents, business and commercial establishments of every kind and nature are requested and urged to honor and comply with this Proclamation.
