

MAYORS PROCLAMATION  
CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA

6th APRIL 1949

WHEREAS: THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA HAS PROCLAIMED APRIL 6th 1949 AS ARMY DAY AND HAS CALLED UPON ALL CITIZENS EVERYWHERE IN AN APPROPRIATE TRIBUTE TO OUR NATIONS DEFENDERS AND

WHEREAS: THE ARMY OF THE UNITED STATES HAS FOR ITS MISSION THE PROTECTION OF THE RIGHT OF THE PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES TO LIVE IN A FREE DEMOCRACY AND AND HAS PRESERVED THE LIBERTY OF OUR BELOVED COUNTRY AGAINST ALL AGRESSORS, AND

WHEREAS: THE SOLDIERS OF OUR ARMY ARE ENAGED IN THE TASK OF BUILDING A FIRM, LAST-SECURITY FOR ALL PEOPLE WHO HAVE SUFFERED THE TRAGEDY OF AGRESSION AND AND STAND TODAY AS A POWERFUL BULWARK AGAINST AGRESSOR NATIONS AROUND THE GLOBE,

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ERNEST CRAIG, MAYOR OF THE CITY LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE 6th APRIL 1949 TO BE ARMY DAY.

AND I CALL UPON ALL CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS TO BE MINDFUL OF THE FACT THAT OUR ARMY CAN ACCOMPLISH ITS MISSION, BOTH AT HOME AND ABROAD, ONLY WITH THE CONSTANT AWARENESS AND GENEROUS SUPPORT OF OUR PEOPLE.

ARMY DAY IS ALSO DEDICATED TO THOSE HEROIC SOLDIERS WHO GAVE THEIR LIVES TO ESTABLISH A PEACEFUL AMERICA THAT MUST REMAIN STRONG IF IT IS TO PRESERVE IT'S HERITAGE.
