

PROCLAMATION

The inhabitants of the City of Las Vegas have always had just cause to be proud of the appearance of our City. Its cleanliness has done much to add to its natural beauty and make it a worthwhile place in which to live. It has so favorably impressed our visitors that they invariably take away with them pleasant thoughts of time well spent here and a desire to return.

A campaign is underway to further intensify our efforts in keeping our City clean and free of all unsightly things and conditions which may mar its appearance.

I, therefore, as Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, hereby proclaim the week commencing October 24 and ending October 31, 1949, as "Clean Up Week" and strongly urge the residents of our City to cooperate fully in this campaign by doing everything possible to keep the streets of this City and other places open to public view, clean and free from all refuse and other unsightly objects and conditions.
