

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the public-spirited citizens of this city of Las Vegas, Nevada, have worked ceaselessly, tirelessly, and in the common cause of humanity, charity, good-fellowship and goodwill; and,

WHEREAS, these citizens have given their all, far above and beyond that which is necessary, in a spirit of oneness, in order to make this city of ours a better place in which to live, and

WHEREAS, through their united and unselfish efforts they have brought great honor, attention and international respect to this city.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE KNOWN that I, C. D. Baker, Mayor of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim and declare that the day of February 12, 1952, Lincoln's Birthday, shall be known as

LAS VEGAS DAY

ALSO LET IT BE KNOWN, that on this day, this city shall celebrate and commemorate this occasion with an event of world-wide importance, the world premiere of the RKO Radio motion picture, "The Las Vegas Story" at the Fremont and Huntbridge Theatres. That in celebrating the citizens of Las Vegas will once again call attention to this city through the press and communications of America--attention to the great heart, charitable spirit, and complete oneness of it's citizens, for all funds derived from this premiere, shall be given to the Las Vegas Tent of Variety Club's Heart Fund--a fund which is dedicated to the cause, that our handicapped children may have opportunities that might otherwise be impossible.

ONCE AGAIN I call on all citizens of Las Vegas and the surrounding territory, to come to Las Vegas February 12, to participate in this worthy cause that can only bring greater honor to the name Las Vegas
