

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Disabled American Veterans is a veterans' organization founded in 1920 and chartered by Congress and charged with the major duty of service to America's disabled veterans of all wars, their dependents, widows and orphans; and

WHEREAS, all members of the Disabled American Veterans are disabled or partially disabled by various handicaps incurred in active service in the armed forces of the United States in time of war; and

WHEREAS, the Forget-Me-Not is the official flower of the Disabled American Veterans and the sale of Forget-Me-Nots is an annual fund-raising drive for the disabled veterans and their families; and

WHEREAS, all money raised from this drive is used by the local Disabled American Veterans Chapter in its rehabilitation and welfare service among disabled servicemen and their dependents of this community; and

WHEREAS, the purchase and wearing of Forget-Me-Nots shows that you will "Forget-~~THEM~~-Not".

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. D. BAKER, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby declare that Saturday, May 10, 1952 shall be

"FORGET-ME-NOT DAY"

in the City of Las Vegas.
