whereas, the last legal date for registration for voting in the State of Nevada Primary election on September 2, 1952, is Saturday, August 2, 1952,

Therefore, Thursday, July 31, 1952, is hereby proclaimed Registration Day in the City of Las Vegas, and

All citizens of the City are urged to register with the County Clerk or a Deputy Registrar, as provided by law, and prepare themselves to exercise their privilege and duty to vote in the forthcoming elections.
