WHEREAS, Art enters into all phases of our lives,
into our homes and schools, and our industry and commerce; and,

WHEREAS, in our own State of Nevada there are many
priceless works of American Artists, which remind us of the
genius for creative that has always existed in this country;
and,

WHEREAS, there are many contemporary Artists working
in the State of Nevada.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAYOR C. D. BAKER, Mayor of the
City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim the period from November
1st through the 7th, 1952 as

AMERICAN ART WEEK

in Las Vegas, and urge our citizens to join in its observance
and thereby encourage and inspire contemporary artists by helping
to draw attention to their work and to the work of American Ar-
tists of the past.
