WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Las Vegas are vitally interested in our youth and recognize the importance of adult participation in matters pertaining to the welfare of our children, and

WHEREAS, one of the principal tasks facing our nation and our community today is the building of our youth into useful and honorable citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that we make every effort to keep all children from being prey to any form of delinquency and to foster all good and proper endeavors aimed at helping our youth to achieve the benefits offered by the American way of life; and

WHEREAS, through the efforts of the Salvation Army who sponsor a group of girls known as the SUNBEAM TROOP which is a Junior Group of Girl Guards; said Sunbeam Troop which provides many suitable interests for the little girls and trains them in the things that will help them to lead happy, useful lives; and

WHEREAS, The Salavation Army has requested that a day be set aside to focus attention on the accomplishments of this group of girls ranging in age from eight to thirteen, the purpose of said day being to provide assistance to help these children to enjoy some of the benefits normally accruing to girls of this great American democracy.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.D. BAKER, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Las Vegas do hereby designate Saturday, March 28, 1952 as

SUNBEAM DAY

in the City of Las Vegas and do call upon all citizens to support the objectives of this day and to cooperate by purchasing a SUNBEAM FLOWER from these groups in order that they might raise funds to send their group to a Summer Camp located in Oracle, Arizona.
