A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, It is most desirable and highly appropriate that at least one day each year be set aside, specifically, so that all individuals may make public expression of their respect and honor for the men and women who demonstrate their patriotic devotion to these United States by service in the Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS, The honorable Charles E. Wilson, Secretary of Defense, has set Saturday, May 16th, as Armed Forces Day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ~~CHARLES H. RUSSELL~~, ^{C D BAKER MAYOR CD} Governor of ~~the State of Nevada~~, by the power in me vested, do hereby proclaim

ARMED FORCES DAY IN NEVADA

~~and direct the Adjutant General of Nevada to take such action as may be proper to insure appropriate observance by units of the National Guard.~~
I further call upon all public officials and agencies of government to cooperate in this observance, inviting all groups of patriotic citizens, including veterans, women's, fraternals, educational, religious, commercial, labor and industrial groups to participate actively in the Armed Forces Day Program in their communities to the end that we may all join in honoring the Armed Forces and in emphasizing the direct relationship of each citizen to the continuing effort of these United States for peace and freedom gained through the strength of a United people.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be affixed the Great Seal of the State of Nevada this 29th day of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three.
