

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the National Chiropractic Association, and its affiliate, the Chiropractic Association of Nevada, have designated a week for the Nation to observe the benefits of good posture; and

WHEREAS, all the people of this State and Nation are vitally interested in having good health for ourselves and our children; and

WHEREAS, men of science are agreed that good posture is one of the most important requisites for attaining and preserving good health and accelerating individual efficiency; and

as

CORRECT POSTURE WEEK IN LAS VEGAS

and invite the citizens of Las Vegas to join with the Chiropractic Association in its educational program, which is designed to make people generally aware of the value of correct posture, as a vital factor in health attainments.
