3 WHEREAS, October 24, 1954, the anniversary of the coming into
4 force of the Charter of the United Nations, has been designated as United
5 Nations Day by the General Assembly of the United Nations and by proclama-
6 tion of the President of the United States; and

7 WHEREAS, the United Nations, in its brief years of organization, has
8 demonstrated that it is the proven instrument for promotion of international
9 peace; and


10 WHEREAS, the United Nations, through its specialized agencies dealing
11 with international problems of health, welfare, trade, labor and human rights,
12 has laid the ground work for economic and social progress; and

13 WHEREAS, most of the member countries of the United Nations are
14 preparing to celebrate this October 24th with fitting observances by all
15 their citizens; and

16 WHEREAS, it is deemed most fitting that the week of October 20th
17 through October 27th, should be celebrated as UNITED NATIONS WEEK in the
18 City of Las Vegas, Nevada.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. D. BAKER, Mayor of Las Vegas, Nevada, do
20 hereby proclaim that the week beginning October 20th through October 27th,
21 to be UNITED NATIONS WEEK, and that Sunday and Monday, October 24th & 25th
22 1954, shall be more particularly celebrated as UNITED NATIONS DAYS, and
23 that such times shall be set aside by every citizen of this community as
24 days of celebration and days to be honored in our homes, our schools, our
25 churches, our meeting places and our places of work and recreation; and
26 that I call upon every person to give his enthusiastic interest and parti-
27 cipation at these times, so that we of this community may demonstrate to
28 the world that our faith and support stand behind the United Nations for
29 the promotion of World peace and progress, in which we all shall share.

30 IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be
31 affixed the seal of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada this 14th day of October, 1954.
