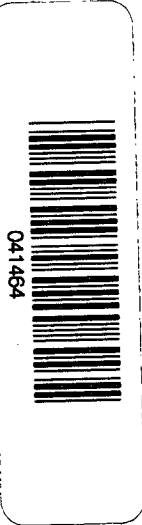
NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. D. BAKER, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim the period of November 28 through December 6 as
