WHEREAS, the first permanent white colony was established in Las Vegas, Nevada, on June 14, 1855, by a party of Latter Day Saint Missionaries, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that this event, with its great significance in the historical background and heritage of the community of Las Vegas and the surrounding areas, be commemorated on the 100th anniversary thereof, and

WHEREAS, a committee has been appointed by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints to organize a suitable celebration in commemoration of this event,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. D. BAKER, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim the week of June 7th to June 14th, 1955 as

" CENTENNIAL WEEK "

and by this proclamation is hereby declared and set aside for the purpose of commemorating the aforementioned event, and all people of Las Vegas and vicinity are urged to give to the said committee and celebration their whole-hearted support, and the business houses of Las Vegas and vicinity are encouraged to give recognition to this event in some manner appropriate to the occasion.
