4 WHEREAS, the establishment and equipping of public recreation
5 and playground facilities are of paramount importance to every community,
6 and

7 WHEREAS, its facilities are available to every resident as well
8 as to visitors who frequent our city, and

9 WHEREAS, the civic pride which we, as citizens, feel is
10 expressed through such monuments to the growth and progress of a city,
11 and it behooves us to support and develop all such civic functions
12 designed for the betterment of our community and the well regulated
13 control and pleasure of our children,

14 NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. D. BAKER, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas,
15 in recognition of the urgent need for well equipped city recreational
16 facilities and the need for more city playgrounds, do proclaim the week
17 of May 2nd to May 9th, 1955 as

18 "LION'S BROOM DRIVE WEEK"

19 and urge all of the residents of our city to support the annual broom
20 drive conducted by the Downtown Las Vegas Lion's Club in their effort
21 to provide funds with which to acquire equipment for the city recrea-
22 tional system and in that manner to lend your concerted support to the
23 development of this city need. In this manner, we will not only be
24 supporting "Our Town"; but will in addition thereto lend material aid
25 to the local efforts to combat juvenile delinquency.
