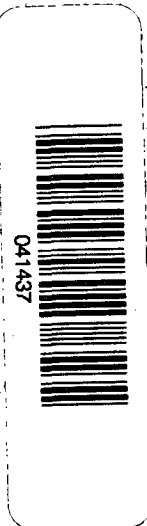
"EMERGENCIES DON'T WAIT WEEK"
