A PROCLAMATION BY THE MAYOR

WHEREAS, by joint resolution passed by the National Congress and signed by the President, the first full week of October of each year has been established as "National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week"; and

WHEREAS, appropriate ceremonies are to be held throughout the nation during this week, to enlist public support for, and interest in, the employment of otherwise qualified but physically handicapped workers, and

WHEREAS, the Governor of Nevada has issued a proclamation setting aside the week of October 7 through October 13, 1956, as "Employ the Physically Handicapped Week" in the state of Nevada,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. D. BAKER, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim


