1 WHEREAS, the fight for freedom in Hungary was cruelly
2 crushed by Soviet tyranny; and

3 WHEREAS, the welfare of the people throughout the world
4 without regard to race, creed, color or religion is the concern
5 of all citizens of the United States and the City of Las Vegas;

8 WHEREAS, the citizens of the United States and of the City
9 of Las Vegas have always in the past responded to a call for
10 relief for those people in other countries less fortunate than
11 they; and

12 WHEREAS, all we can do now for the valiant Hungarian people
13 is to provide medical care for the wounded and furnish to them
14 medicines, food, clothing and other necessities as a token of
15 our admiration, love and sympathy; and

17 WHEREAS, the American Red Cross and the Junior Chamber of
18 Commerce have volunteered their services to collect and dis-
19 tribute all contributions which may be received; and

21 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the citizens of Las
22 Vegas set aside a period for the collection of clothing, drugs,
23 and money for these humane purposes;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, I, REED WHIPPLE, Mayor Pro Tem of the City
25 of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim the week of December 2nd through
26 December 8th, 1956 as

27 "AID FOR HUNGARY WEEK"

28 in Las Vegas, and urge all citizens to contribute clothing, drugs
29 and funds to the valiant Hungarian people as a token of our
30 admiration, love and sympathy, and I further urge all citizens
