WHEREAS, each year, on the anniversary of the passage of the Civil Service Act of 1883, the American Federation of Government Employees sponsors special programs and activities to acquaint the public with the history and principles of the merit system.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. D. BAKER, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do proclaim the week of January 13th through January 20th, 1957 as

CIVIL SERVICE WEEK

and do hereby urge the citizens of this city to join with our Federal employees in the observance of the seventy-fourth anniversary of the signing of the Civil Service Act.
