PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on June 14, 1777, the American Flag was adopted by the Congress of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the date of June 14 in each year has long been observed and commemorated by young and old as one of our most significant days; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that our people should pay tribute to the Flag under which those pioneers, statesmen, military men, and other American citizens developed and brought to fruition all the benefits and advantages of this great country of ours; and

WHEREAS, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of Las Vegas is sponsoring a celebration of Flag Day on Friday, June 14, by a luncheon in conjunction with the State Encampment of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. D. BAKER, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim that June 14, 1957 be set aside as

"FLAG DAY"

in the City of Las Vegas, and I urge all citizens and business organizations to observe this Day by displaying the Flag at their homes and places of business.
