WHEREAS, the fifth Annual Air Cruise sponsored by the Philadelphia Junior Chamber of Commerce will start on Saturday, July 13, at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and end at Las Vegas on Friday, July 19, 1957, and

WHEREAS, this cross-country Air Cruise will be composed of flying families from virtually every state in the Union, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Air Cruise is to: Foster and encourage private aviation; demonstrate the utility of light aircraft for business and pleasure flying; provide an opportunity for a flying vacation; and promote and publicize nationwide private aviation facilities, and


WHEREAS, the selection of Las Vegas as the terminal point for the end of the Cruise will bring both recognition and business to our City.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, REED WHIPPLE, Mayor Pro Tem of the City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim Friday, July 19, 1957 as

"JAYCEE AIR CRUISE DAY"

in the City of Las Vegas, and I urge as many citizens as possible to welcome these pilots and their families when they arrive at McCarran Air Field on Friday, July 19th.
