11 our youth to achieve the benefits offered by the American way  
12 of life; and

13           WHEREAS, through the joint efforts of KIWANIS INTER-  
14 NATIONAL and the local KIWANIS clubs, a day has been set aside  
15 to focus attention upon the problems and the accomplishments of  
16 youth throughout the forty-eight states at both a national and  
17 community level; said day to be identified with the objective
