**W**HEREAS, the purpose of the National Football Foundation in honoring the heroes of the past in the Hall of Fame is to remind our youth and all of our people through great historical exhibits and through print and over the air that there shall be no softening of our fibre as we face the task of world leadership;

**N**OW, therefore, I, C. D. Baker, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim and designate the period between October the eighteenth and October the twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, as NATIONAL FOOTBALL FOUNDATION AND HALL OF FAME WEEK and do earnestly recommend that throughout the City of Las Vegas all of the people take cognizance of the significant services rendered to our youth, our State and our Nation by the National Football Foundation and Hall of Fame, and I do further recommend that the noble cause of amateur football be aided through the support of this organization's fine principles and continuing programs by all people of this City.
