

P R O C L A M A T I O N

1 INDIVIDUAL freedom under law is the birthright of all Americans.
2 Laws and courts exist to protect every citizen, in his person and property,
3 and in the individual rights and privileges he enjoys under our federal and
4 state constitutions.

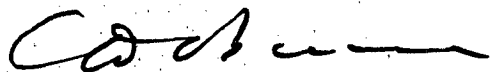
5 It is this liberty and equality for the individual which distinguishes
6 our system of government from communism, under which millions of people are
7 today living in slavery. Without laws and courts the freedoms we often take
8 for granted would be meaningless.

9 This important truth is to be recognized publicly in a nation-wide
10 observance of LAW DAY--U.S.A. to be held on May 1, 1959. The citizens of
11 Las Vegas have been invited to participate. The observance will consist of
12 special programs sponsored by various organizations and groups, and by the
13 schools. Their purpose will be to focus public attention on the important
14 part that law has played in America's growth and achievement.

15 The present status of world affairs makes it especially fitting
16 that our people should at this time reaffirm their faith in the rule of law
17 and their determination to strengthen it. This is both a timely and patriotic
18 observance emphasizing respect for law and good citizenship. It merits the
19 support and cooperation of individuals, organizations and schools.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. D. BAKER, Mayor of Las Vegas do hereby proclaim
21 Friday, May 1, 1959, as LAW DAY--U.S.A. in Las Vegas and call upon all citizens,
22 organizations and schools to recognize this special day and to join in its
23 observance.
