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P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, September 17, 1959, is notable as marking the one hundred seventy-second anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, to accord official recognition to this memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic exercise which will form a noteworthy feature of the occasion, seems fitting and proper; and

WHEREAS, Public Law No. 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 of each year as Constitution Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Las Vegas in the State of Nevada, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 - 23, 1959 as

"CONSTITUTION WEEK"

in the City of Las Vegas, and urge all our citizens to pay special attention during that week to our Federal Constitution and the advantages of American citizenship.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the City of Las Vegas to be affixed this 14th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and the independence of the United States of America, the one hundred and eighty-third.
