

P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952 requires that every alien in the United States, except diplomats, persons officially connected with international organizations of which the United States is a member, and other admitted temporarily as agricultural laborers, must report his address during January of each year; and

WHEREAS, this law requires such an address report though the address of the alien has not changed since the last address report; and

WHEREAS, Address Report Cards may now be obtained at any United States Post Office or Immigration and Naturalization Service Office,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Oran K. Gragson, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, in recognition of the importance of compliance with the law to future citizens of Las Vegas do hereby proclaim the month of January, 1962 as ALIEN ADDRESS REPORT MONTH in Las Vegas, and request all citizens, employees, and officers of the City of Las Vegas to assist and encourage every alien within the City of Las Vegas to report his address at the nearest Post Office or Immigration and Naturalization Service Office during the month of January, 1962.
