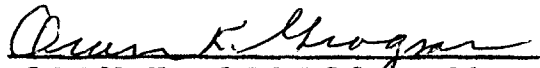
WHEREAS; the lives and property of our people are endangered by fire and accident caused by carelessness and thoughtlessness; and
