WHEREAS; it is fitting that we make every effort to keep all children from being prey to any form of delinquency and to foster all good and proper endeavors aimed at helping our youth to achieve the benefits offered by the American Way of Life; and

WHEREAS; through the joint efforts of Kiwanis International and the local Kiwanis Club, a day has been set aside to focus attention upon the problems and the accomplishments of youth throughout the fifty states (or ten provinces) at both a National and Community level.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Oran K.
