1
2 WHEREAS; the United Nations has clearly demonstrated its capacity to
3 act as a force for peace and human advancement, and has pro-
4 vided a dynamic spirit which is leading the nations of the world
5 along the road to human progress; and

6 WHEREAS; the United States strongly supports the United Nations, the
7 Charter of which is rooted in ideals and aspirations which we
8 share with freedom-loving people in all parts of the world; and

10 WHEREAS; The United States considers that this world organization is an
11 indispensable instrument of international peace, economic
12 improvement, and social development, and that any attempt to
13 destroy it would be a blow aimed directly at the independence
14 and security of nations, large and small; and

16 WHEREAS; The General Assembly of the United Nations has resolved that
17 October 24, 1963 is the anniversary of the coming into force of
18 the United Nations Charter, should be dedicated each year to
19 making known the purposes, principles, and accomplishments
20 of the United Nations.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, I, Oran K. Gragson, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas do
22 hereby urge the citizens of the City to observe Tuesday, October
23 24, 1963 as United Nations Day.
