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3 WHEREAS; the provision of educational opportunity in our community is
4 an eternal debt of this generation to the next; and

5 WHEREAS; education is an essential basis for America's freedom, security,
6 and prosperity; and

7 WHEREAS; education is confronted by unparalleled problems, such as
8 shortages in teacher supply, classrooms, and finance, which
9 can be solved only by public understanding and public action; and

11 WHEREAS; a rapidly changing world requires that education change to meet
12 new challenges without diminishing the traditional American
13 Appreciation of the worth of the individual, the obligations of
14 responsible citizenship, the dignity of constructive employment,
15 and the value of the basic moral and spiritual values.

18 Vegas do hereby designate November 10 - 16, 1963 as
19 "AMERICAN EDUCATION WEEK" and urge all citizens
