1 WHEREAS; St. Patrick brought Christianity to Ireland in the 5th Century
2 after Christ, taught the natives about the love and saving
3 grace of God, and brought the people of an isolated land into
4 touch with Western Europe and Rome; and

6 WHEREAS; his influence and faith are still a potent force, not only in
7 Erin but throughout the world; and

9 WHEREAS; his imprint on the Irish has made them pre-eminent in many
10 fields--among others, in humor, in their loyalty to their
11 faith and friends, in their gift of blarney and flair for public
12 service; and

13 WHEREAS; of the millions of Irishmen now in the United States, many
14 reside in Nevada and are treasured among our most highly
15 respected citizens and best friends; and

16 WHEREAS; it is fitting that we pay homage to this great Saint by annually
17 setting aside a day in his name.

20 Vegas do hereby proclaim March 17, 1964 as
21 "ST. PATRICK'S DAY" in the City of Las Vegas and
