18 to the observance of National Transportation Week.

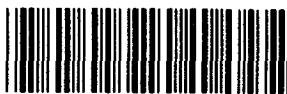
19 NOW, THEREFORE, I, Oran K. Gragson, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas
