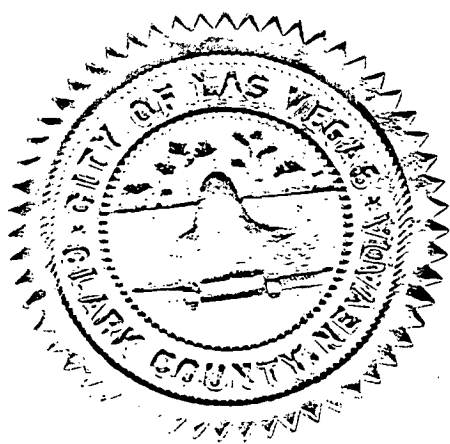

WHEREAS; fully convinced that the citizens of Las Vegas are eager to enlist in the fight to save human lives, I appeal to every man, woman and child to join wholeheartedly in this effort for greater safety. Let each of us exercise increased care in walking and driving and greater caution in decorating our homes for the holidays; and

WHEREAS; Let us keep in mind the fact that each of us has the tremendous moral responsibility to do the utmost to protect the lives and safety of others while we labor to spare ourselves and our loved ones the horror of tragedy.
