WHEREAS, Sertoma International has promoted the distribution of copies of the Declaration of Independence throughout its entire membership of clubs; and

WHEREAS, The Sertoma Club of Las Vegas is planning to carry out special patriotic and civic activities during the 1965 Freedom Week; and

WHEREAS, It seems proper and fitting to accord official recognition to this patriotic movement,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Oran K.
