in Las Vegas, and do call upon all organizations of whatever kind, and upon public, parochial and private schools to emphasize the study of American History during this designated month.

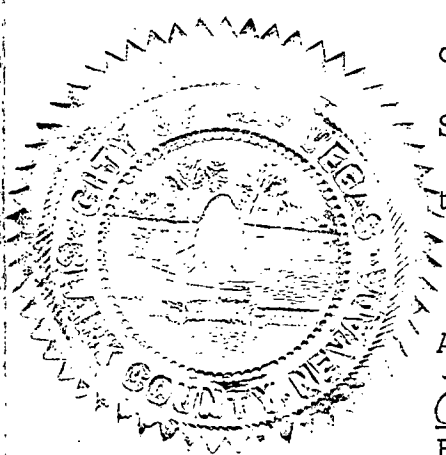
