WHEREAS, the week beginning February 13, 1966, has been set aside as "NATIONAL NEGRO HISTORY WEEK,"; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this week is to call attention to the many outstanding contributions made to American progress by members of the Negro race; and

WHEREAS, it is urged that a better understanding, a more tolerant attitude and a greater appreciation may be had for members of this race,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim the week beginning February 13, 1966, as NATIONAL NEGRO HISTORY WEEK IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, and I hereby urge all citizens to give thought to this memorial week so that a more tolerant attitude and greater appreciation for members of the Negro race may be had.
