WHEREAS, "HELLO AMERICA" is the type of production that has created a patriotic spirit throughout the nation; and

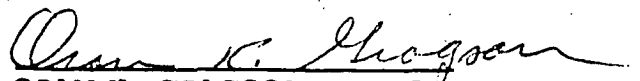
WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has paid tribute to this enlightening performance; and

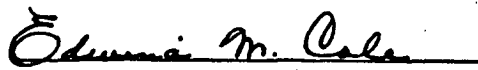
