WHEREAS, the beauty of our communities and countryside is being destroyed by careless littering; and

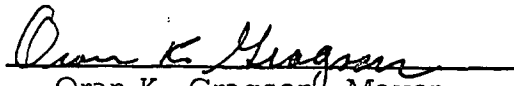
WHEREAS, our state and local governments are spending hundreds of thousands of dollars each year for litter cleanup along our streets and highways, and in our parks and public buildings; and

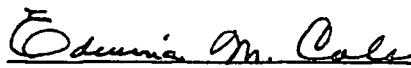
WHEREAS, it should be the duty of every individual and organization to support the beautification program and combat the problem of littering;
