WHEREAS, Electric light increasingly contributes to the shaping and progress of American society; and


WHEREAS, The use of electric light in the United States grows at a rate of 9 per cent annually as the cost of light to the user continues to decrease; and

WHEREAS, Lamp manufacturers this year will make more than 3 billion electric light sources of 10,000 sizes and types to meet the nation's lighting needs; and


WHEREAS, The electric lamp business plays an invaluable role in helping improve the health, satisfaction, productivity and security of the American people;

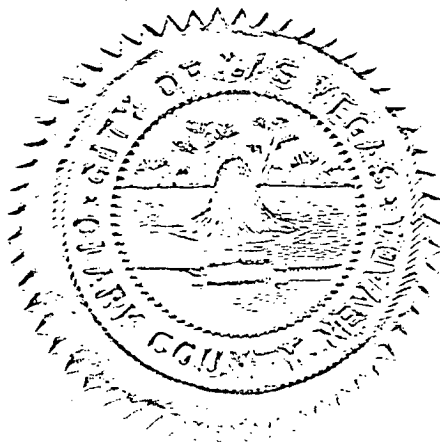
