WHEREAS, The Salvation Army embarks this year on its second century of service to God and man, and

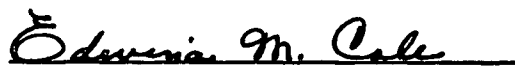

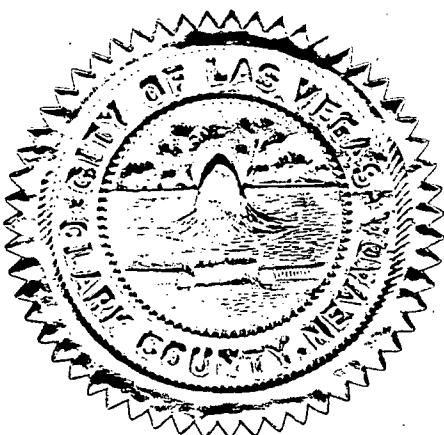
