WHEREAS, the dangers around the home and while swimming, camping, fishing, hunting, boating and traveling by auto are many; and

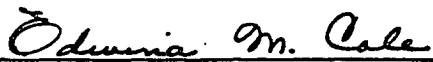

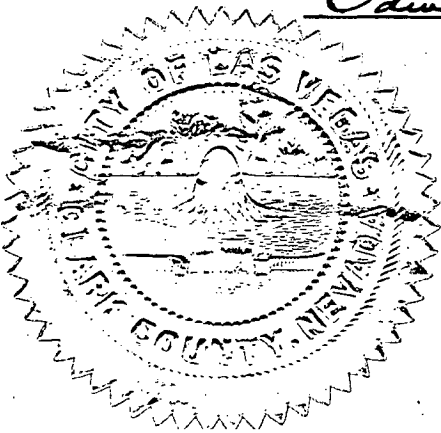
