WHEREAS, membership is open to women who are active in all phases of construction; and

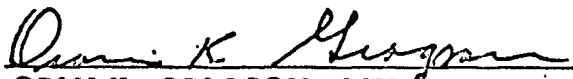

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Oran K. Gragson, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas do proclaim September 11 through September 17, 1966 as

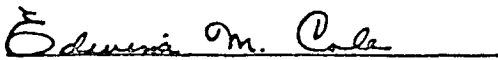
"WOMEN IN CONSTRUCTION WEEK"

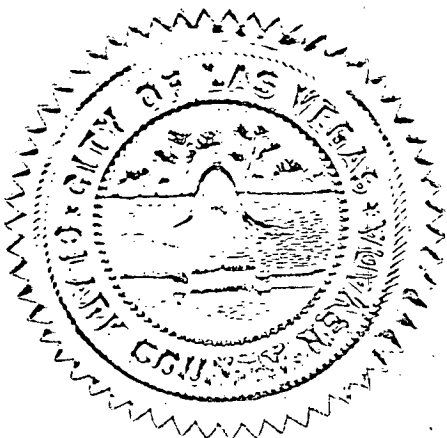
and urge all citizens to give just recognition and honor to the women participating in the construction industry.
