

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS,

Nevadans may well take pride in the progress of their Highway Program. While activity has increased in recent years in all phases of highway work, in the area of Freeway construction the growth has been phenomenal.

This mushroom growth in road building and all its related activities, proceeding with inevitable stresses, has taken place with a creditable record of accomplishment in terms of many miles of high standard highways.

Vehicles traversing these highways, both from within our borders and from all parts of the Nation, contribute to our economic health and well being.

It is important that Nevadans understand and appreciate the contribution of highway transportation to their social and economic progress and that they recognize the individuals and industries that have made our highway transportation system possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Oran K. Gragson, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby proclaim the week beginning September 18, 1966 as NATIONAL HIGHWAY WEEK in Nevada. In recognition of the current emphasis upon highway beautification it seems right and proper to have this observance with the theme of ROADWAY BEAUTIFICATION and I ask that civic officials and community leaders and the general public join in this observance.
