WHEREAS, CARE'S gifts are on a person-to-person basis, going to the people directly for their personal training and use, bringing immediate relief from hunger, illiteracy and suffering, thus establishing a tie between donors and recipients; and

WHEREAS, CARE is launching its Annual Fall Food Crusade to send 7,000,000 packages of food this year to hungry men, women and children around the world; and

WHEREAS, CARE is asking the people of LAS VEGAS and all over America to assist in sending food, self-help and educational supplies and medical assistance through MEDICO, a service of CARE, as a gesture of friendship to less fortunate peoples around the globe; and

WHEREAS, the very word, CARE, symbolizes the desire of Americans to take a personal part in helping build a better world for all peoples;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Oran K. Gragson, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas do hereby proclaim the week of October 16 to 22, 1966 be designated as

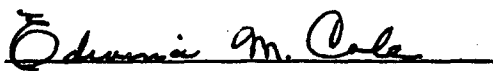
"CARE WEEK"

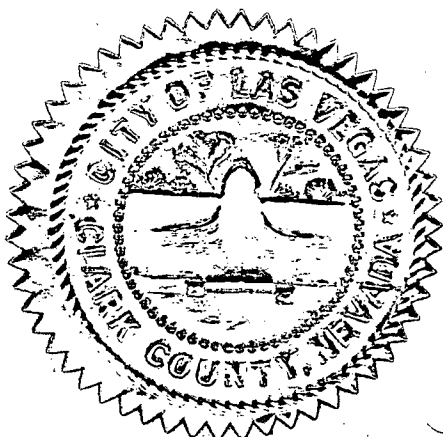
