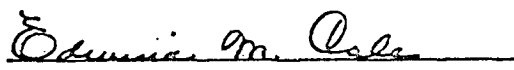

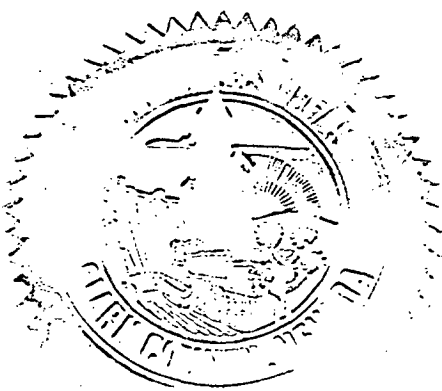
nationally and urge all citizens of our community to give full consideration to the future services of the Jaycees.
