WHEREAS, for a number of years the Society for the study of Negro Life and History has sponsored a week during the month of February for the observance of this worthy purpose; and

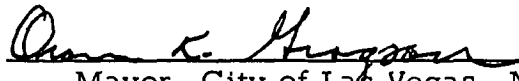
