

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the citizens of Las Vegas and their fellow Americans throughout the nation will observe the Golden Anniversary of World War I on April 6, 1967; and

WHEREAS, the Declaration of War was signed by President Woodrow Wilson on April 6, 1917; and

WHEREAS, more than four million Americans answered the call to defend their country during this War; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately two million surviving veterans of World War I; and

WHEREAS, there will be a meeting at the American Legion Hall on April 12, 1967, at 8:00 P.M., in honor of this Anniversary, to which all veterans of World War I are invited.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby proclaim April 6, 1967, as the GOLDEN ANNIVERSARY OF WORLD WAR I, and urge that the citizens of this City take appropriate notice and recognition thereof.
