WHEREAS, TWA commenced its services in this community with DC-3 twenty-one passenger airplanes and, in the betterment of its service, was the first all jet airline in this city, commencing said service in October of 1962 and, as of August, 1967, TWA enplaned and deplaned 61,714 passengers in the city; and

WHEREAS, TWA has recently provided international direct service from Las Vegas to Paris and Rome and also direct service to Madrid and Tripoli and is contemplating additional international service as well as local service; and

WHEREAS, TWA will be the first airline in this city providing gate holding positions for passengers in the near future.

in this community, and hereby commend its excellent service to the residents of this community over the past thirty years.
